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CLASS SPECIFICATIONS- Hunter Divisions

The rated sections of this competition are official USEF point competitions for USEF National and USEF Zone Horse of the Year Awards Programs. All hunter classes to be judged on performance and soundness. Courses will consist of at least eight fences with changes of direction. Fences will simulate obstacles found in the hunt field, such as brush, post and rails, walls, in and outs, gates, etc. No bank or water jumps. Handy hunter courses and jumps to simulate those found in trappy hunt country, and may include natural obstacles, a trot fence and a fence to lead over.

Minimum entry requirements to follow USEF and Zone rules.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to horses of any age eligible to compete in their respective Green Division. Horses must be enrolled in the USHJA Green Hunter Incentive Program prior to competing. Horses may only be enrolled online. Incentive will run concurrently with the respective Green divisions. See Schedule for Class. SPECIFICATIONS: To be judged on quality, movement, jumping style, manners, and way of going, using the open numerical scoring system. Judges will compare incentive horses against other incentive horses. POINTS AND AWARDS: National HOTY points/ money are awarded to each horse's respective Green Hunter height section. Horses will be awarded both HOTY points and the value of their prize money won. PRIZE MONEY: Distributed 1-12 Overall. 50% addback included.

USHJA PONY HUNTER DERBY 410. \$1500 USHJA Pony Hunter Derby Entry Fee: \$125 + \$25 USHJA Fee

ELIGIBILITY: Open to ponies with a valid measurement card. Riders may compete on a total of four (4) ponies, but no more than two (2) of any size. Pony must have competed in at least two classes over fences at the competition. SPECIFICATIONS: Two round classic. Set order of go for the rst round, arranged by pony height. e top 12 will return in reverse order of rst round score within respective height. e rst round will be the Classic Hunter Style round, judged on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. e second round is the Handy Hunter round. Handiness will be taken into the base score. Score from the two rounds will be combined to determine the overall scores and winners.

USHJA NATIONAL HUNTER DERBY 411. \$5000 USHJA National Hunter Derby Entry Fee: \$300 + \$25 USHJA Fee

ELIGIBILITY: Horses must have competed in at least 2 classes over fences in the same week to compete. ORDER OF GO: Order of Go for the first round will be drawn. Order of Go for the second round will be reverse order of scores from the first round. If a jump off is needed, order will be the same from the second round.

ATTIRE: Formal jacket required. Buff breeches and shadbelly, white breeches and dark or scarlet coat, hunt colors or official sponsor/team jacket permitted.

SCHOOLING: During the class, all horses must be ridden in official schooling areas. Riders must wear their horse's competition number.

RIDER MEETING: There will be a Rider Meeting before the start of the class.

SPECIFICATIONS: First Round: Classic Hunter Style Round to be judged and numerically scored on quality, movement, jumping style, manners, and way of going. Judged over a course of at least 10 obstacles set at 3. In addition to this base score, each judging panel must award an Option Bonus Score consisting of one additional point for every higher option jumped. Option Fences set at 3.5. Scores will be added to determine the total first round score. The top 12 will return for the Second Round, ties for 12th broken by base score.

SECOND ROUND: Handy Hunter Round to be judged and numerically scored on quality, movement, jumping style, manners, and way of going. Judged over a course of at least 8 obstacles set at 3'. Handiness is worked into the base score. Added to the base score is the Option Bonus Score consisting of one additional point for every higher height option jumped. Option Fences set at 3'5". The scores will be combined for the total Second Round Score.

Scores from the First and Second Rounds will be added to determine overall winners. Ties for all places other than first to be broken by the base score from the Second Round. Child and Adult Hunter: Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class and any class where otherwise eligible.

Adults who compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter and/or Jumper classes may show other horses that they own in the Adult Amateur Hunters. Riders competing in the Amateur Owner 3'3" section (but not competing in the Amateur Owner 3'6" section) may ride one horse that they do not own in the Adult Amateur Hunter section. Children may compete one different horse in the Junior 3'3" Hunter section, but may not cross-enter into any Junior 3'6" Hunter or Junior Jumper class at the same show. Child Hunter Pony riders may show only one pony in either the 2'0" or the 2'6" height of the Children's Hunter Pony section when also competing in the Regular Small, Medium or Large Pony and/or Green Pony Hunter sections. Child Hunter Pony riders cannot cross enter into any class where fences exceed 3'3" (exception: Riders may show in Pony Jumpers).

Horses/Ponies: Horses and ponies exhibiting in the Children's Hunter section may cross enter multiple sections of Children's Hunter and any classes where eligible. Ponies exhibiting in Children's Hunter Pony may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible but the rider may not show the same pony in the regular pony section.

Child and Adult Equitation: No cross entry restrictions.

Child and Adult Jumper: Riders competing in the Children's or Adult Amateur Jumper Classic may not compete in any other Jumper Classic, Welcome Stake, Mini Prix, or Grand Prix at 1.30m or above or in the highest prize money class of any 1.30m or above section at the same show.

Horse and Rider Combination: Low Children or Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same show. Low Children's or Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered. RULES & REGULATIONS

Each competition must be conducted in accordance with applicable USEF rules. Entry into the competition represents acknowledgment and acceptance, with no appeal, to these competition rules for all classes.

ORGANIZING COMMITTEE DECISIONS

It is important to understand that interpretations of existing rules and regulations and the invoking of additional rules and regulations to cover unforeseen circumstances are the sole responsibility and authority with, and with the approval of the Ground Jury and that all owner, trainer, chiefs, competitors, and grooms agree to the acceptance of these interpretations and additional rulings by virtue of your participation. Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to cancel any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or judges; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule or as competition warrants, or make any changes management deems is in the best interest of the show and its exhibitors.

ENTRY INFORMATION

A separate entry form (online, print, email) must be filled out for each horse. Each entry must be signed by the owner, rider, trainer, and coach (if applicable) and said signatures shall constitute verification that the information contained thereon is accurate to the best of the signer's knowledge and belief. Deposit must be paid with each entry, and an open check or credit card must be on file in the show office before back numbers will be issued. Entries and Stalls will be limited. Competitors are encouraged to get their entries in early. Entries received after stalls have sold out will be placed on a waitlist in order of received entries. Late entries (received after the closing date) will be charged a \$50 late entry fee. Under extreme circumstances, management reserves the right to accept or deny any entry. Any entry scratched after the closing date is responsible for stabling fees and a \$75 show scratch fee. there is no fee for horse substitutions. Under certain circumstances and/ or veterinary verification letter, Management reserves the right to enforce or waive fees. All horses must pay an office fee of \$75. This office fee also permits each horse to properly add/scratch regular classes. Classes may be added and scratched prior to the class starting at no fee. When possible, please add entries to classes the day before to help with scheduling. Scratching at the in-gate does not scratch the class and the class fee will still be charged. If a horse is shown in a class it was not properly entered in, it will be charged a \$25 Ride Did Not Enter (RDNE) fee in addition to the class fee. Entries can be done by 3pm through the app or in the office until 4pm. All fees, unless otherwise noted, are weekly fees and will be charged each week the horse is entered. Exhibitprs are responsible for all fees of all horses entered by them or their agents.

NIGHTWATCH AND OTHER FEES

NON-SHOWING All horses on the grounds must have a completed entry in the office, complete with signatures. Non-show horses will be charged a \$150 non-showing fee in addition to any stall or trainer splits. Scratched horses present on the grounds are considered non-showing. All horses present on the showgrounds will receive a nightwatch fee.

MOVE IN/MOVE OUT

Move in for TerraNova February I will be Monday, February 12 at 8am. Move out is Monday, February 19 at 8am. Move in for TerraNova February 2 is Monday, February 19 at noon, and move out is Monday, February 26 at 8am. Move in for TerraNova March 1 is Monday, March 11 at noon, and move out is Monday, March 18 at 8 a.m. Move in for TerraNova March 2 is March 18 at noon and move out is March 25 at noon. Horses arriving early will pay \$50 per stall per night. Stalls occupied after the designated move-out time will be charged \$50 per stall, per day. Please contact Olga if you would like to arrive early or stay late to determine IF arrangements can be made.

ORDER OF GO

The Grand Prix ring will have posted orders of go for all classes. Unless specified, classes in the remaining rings will be done by check-in at the in-gate. Orders of Go are produced in accordance with JP 112. Orders of Go are available at the Show Office, at the ring, and on the app.

COMBINING, DIVIDING, OR CANCELLING DIVISIONS

The Decision to Combine, Cancel or Divide classes will be made at the discretion of the Show Management. the update will be reflected on the app and on the How Many schedule.

COMBINING - Once a class/classic/division has been combined due to insufficient entries, it will not be re-divided for additional entries the day of the class.

DIVIDING - A class/classic/division that has been offered as split may be combined on the day of if scratched entries warrant. Management has the right to run all sections of the class/classic/division in their entirety before pinning if insufficient entries seem likely.

CANCELLING - A class/classic/division that has been cancelled due to insufficient entries will not be reinstated for additional entries on the day of the class. All USEF/USHJA rules in effect. Minimum 6 entries required to run a Classic, minimum 3 for any other prize money class not addressed by USEF/USHJA rules.

SPECIAL HUNTER CLASSICS

Judged on soundness and performance with manners and suitability emphasized. To be scored under the open numerical judging system. The top 12 (unless otherwise stated) horses (ponies) from the first round will return in reverse order of their scores in the first round; lowest score going first and highest score going last. In case of ties, order of those tied will be drawn. Scores from both rounds will be averaged to determine the winners. In case of a tie for first place only, judges will confer to break the tie. All other ties will remain and riders will toss a coin for the ribbons.

SEPARATE TWO ROUND CLASSIC - For the first round, each competitor will jump one round of approximately 10-12 fences at the required height, held independently of any other class.

DESIGNATED FIRST ROUND CLASSIC - A designated class of the division will be the first round of the classic. The Classic must be entered PRIOR to competing in the First Round class. A horse shown in the Second Round without being officially entered will incur double the classic entry fee. Scratches are NOT permitted after the First Round class has begun. See schedule for the Designated First Round class.

EQUITATION

Equitation riders must ride the horse and wear the number of the horse they have entered to ride. there is no penalty for the rider to scratch an equitation class from one horse and add it on another horse. Exhibitors who enter an equitation class on one horse and ride or wear another horse's number will be charged on both horses.

SCHOOLING AND WARM UP

The designated schooling arena for the competition will be restricted to only horses warming up to compete in said classes. Horses wishing to school at times other than their designated competition warm-up time must use the arena(s) posted for open flatting/schooling. Management reserves the right to change schooling locations and times to best suit competition arenas due to conditions/weather/schedule/etc.

COURTESY CIRCLE

In some instances it may become necessary to restrict the area of the courtesy circle by the mandatory line. If this is implemented it will be clearly marked on the course chart and a corresponding barrier will be erected on the course. A public announcement will also be made.

TIES

All ties in jumper competition will be broken on the basis of time in accordance with the USEF rules. Hunter and Equitation ties will be kept or broken in accordance with applicable USEF, USHJA, or Zone rules.

MARTINGALES

1.30m or below - no martingale restriction when used in a conventional manner. Classes above 1.30m and all young horses classes may only have running martingales used in a conventional manner. Irish martingales permitted in all classes. Draw reins and German martingales only allowed when schooling or classes 1.20m and below with no prize money, and are not permitted in age restricted classes. Ponies may not be ridden by a junior in draw reins or German martingale at any time.

STALLS

Stabling will be in clearspan tents on a base of crushed gravel under sand. Stalls are 12'x10' or in permanent stalls, 12'x12' with comfort mattress. Doors are provided.

SHARPS

Anyone found discarding sharps in any other manner than the provided sharps containers will be fined up to \$250 per instance and held responsible for any fines or expenses incurred by management.

TRAINER SPLITS, CLOSING ACCOUNTS, AND PRIZE MONEY

You must close out your account no later than the Sunday of the current show week. Balances will not be rolled forward, each week must be closed separately. If you wish for the office to close your account, we will be happy to do so. Please leave clear instructions as to whose check or credit card to use for each horse. Please look over your statement and report any errors to a secretary immediately as to horse's name, riders, owners, addresses, association numbers, etc. Please double check that the Payee for prize money is correct with the correct address. Failure to check out will incur a \$50 late check out fee. All statements become final at the close of business on Sunday. Disputes will not be allowed after this time. Management has permission to close out any outstanding balances with payment information provided. Trainers will be held financially responsible for any clients who do not submit viable payment in a timely manner, including late fees.

TRAINER SPLITS

Trainers may split miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until noon on the Friday of the show week. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected. Only trainers/designated representatives may change a trainer split, and questions regarding trainer splits by clients should be directed towards the trainers.

CREDIT CARD AND CHECK POLICY

The prices in this catalogue reflect a Discount for paying by Cash, Check or other means not involving a credit card. A Retail Price catalogue is available upon request. All foreign competitor balances must be paid in cash, check, drawn on a US bank, or credit card using US funds. Checks returned by the bank and credit card chargebacks will sustain a 10% or \$50 penalty, whichever is less. If not sufficiently paid in 10 days, accounts will be turned over to the USEF.

PRIZE MONEY AND TAX FORMS

Prize money is NOT applied to the invoice at the show. All prize money is mailed within thirty (30) days of the conclusion of the show to the owner listed on the entry form, or the Payee if given. Prize money will only be mailed if the owner's or payee's W-9 Form is on file with the show office, and all balances are paid. Foreign competitors must include a U.S. Tax ID Number on their entry form or will be asked to complete a W-8BEN or W-8 Certicate of Foreign Status Form. A new W-9 form is required for each calendar year.

USEF ENTRY STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, its members, directors, and employees, contractors, sponsoring entities and facility harmless for any loss or accident to horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

ANIMAL WELFARE

Manual poling or the use of bamboo off-sets is prohibited while on the property. Violators will be subject to penalty with the automatic elimination of the horse involved from the class it is competing in and/or the succeeding class in which it was entered and will forfeit all entry fees for that class. Riders/trainers who, in the opinion of the Judges or Committee, use a whip or spurs in a cruel or excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the current and/ or succeeding class in which that horse/rider is entered and will forfeit all entry fees for that class. All incidents may be reported by the USEF steward and to the USEF for possible further investigation.

ACCIDENTS INVOLVING COMPETITORS

GR1317. In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a licensed competition, the competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional. The competitor may be placed on suspension by USEF until a release is provided. Competitors are advised to familiarize themselves with this rule.

LEASH LAWS

Dogs must be on a leash and under control at all times. Dog owners who fail to comply with the USEF rules regarding dogs may be subject to penalty, including \$100 fine per incident, and/or warning cards issued. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dog's behavior.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Golf carts must stay off horse path. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR

It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parents, guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition.

LIABILITY

Under Florida law, a farm animal activity sponsor, farm animal professional, or other person does not have the duty to eliminate all risks of injury of participation in farm animal activites. Events at Terranova, TerraNova Equestrian Center and their affiliated entities, its owner, employees, agents and sponsors shall not be liable or responsible for loss or damage to any animal, person, or property which occurs for any reason during the show. Each exhibitor holds the TerraNova Show Management, its owners, agents, employees, as well as the USEF blameless for any accident or loss which may occur.




